





Piggie Guided Drawing Instructions

Based on Mo Willems' "Piggie" Character



<p>1. Draw an oval for the snout (or nose,) near the top of the page. (You'll need room for the pig's body below it and the rest of the head above it.)</p>	
<p>2. Starting at the side of the snout or nose, draw a rainbow for the rest of the head.</p>	
<p>3. Draw a triangle for each ear. I tell the children that a triangle is like making a capital A with the line on the bottom of it instead of in the middle. But they won't need the bottom line this time!</p>	
<p>4. Draw two lines for the nostrils in the middle of the nose. Draw a big smile for the body below the head.</p>	
<p>5. For the right eye, draw a circle and fill it in. Draw a rainbow for the eyebrow. For the left eye, draw a "slide" (or a diagonal line) as shown. Then draw a smile under it, and fill it in.</p>	


6. For each arm and leg, draw one line going down, and then another next to it. Then have the children draw a V (or an A without the line in it) at the end of the arm or leg to finish it off.



7. For the tail, draw a smile going out, and then another smile going back in.



8. Now your piggie is complete!



9. Color your piggie any way you like.
